

SAMPLE BYLAWS FOR LOCAL CHAPTER

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this organization shall be HOSA, (your school) Chapter.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

Section 1. The purposes of this organization are:

- 1. To unite in a common bond without regard to race, creed, or national origin students enrolled in Health Science Education class or classes.
- 2. To develop leadership that is competent and self-reliant.
- 3. To improve scholarship and develop skills that will enable young men and women to participate effectively in health science education.
- 4. To create more interest and understanding in the intelligent choice of health

careers.

- 6. To recognize outstanding leadership in _____

ARTICLE III - ORGANIZATION

- Section 1. SD HOSA is chartered by the Board of Directors of the National HOSA to provide for state-wide Coordination of the HOSA program.
- Section 2. This Chapter is open to all students interested in a career in healthcare at (your school).
- Section 3. The <u>(your school)</u> HOSA Chapter is supported by our local administration and is led by elected student officers.

ARTICLE IV - MEMBERSHIP

- Section 1. Any dues paying student interested in a healthcare career.
- Section 2. Any dues paying professional in the community who would like to partner with the chapter.

ARTICLE V - OFFICERS

- Section 1. Officers of the (your school) Chapter shall consist of the following:

 President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Reporter, and Historian. They shall constitute the Chapter's Executive Committee. Other officers may be designated as desirable.
- Section 2. The program coordinator(s)/instructor(s) associated with the health science program shall be Advisor(s) to the Chapter.
- Section 3. Officers of the Chapter shall be nominated and elected by a majority vote at the beginning of the school year.
- Section 4. In any other circumstances, the election of officers shall follow parliamentary procedure.

ARTICLE VI - MEETINGS

- Section 1. One business meeting shall be held on the <u>(day)</u> of every month during the fiscal year.
- Section 2. Additional meetings shall be called when necessary.
- Section 3. The Executive Committee meetings will be held at time specified by the President and the local Advisor.
- Section 4. The rules contained in Robert's Rule of Order, Newly Revised, shall govern meetings to



which are applicable.

ARTICLE VII - COMMITTEES

Section 1. Standing committees will be established as needed.

Section 2. Special committees (ad hoc) may be established as needed.

ARTICLE VIII - CONFERENCES

Section 1. The <u>(your school)</u> HOSA chapter will encourage members to participate at the State and National Leadership Conferences.

ARTICLE IX - COMPETITIVE EVENTS

All proposed amendments must be submitted by SD HOSA to the chartered Chapters at least 30 days prior to the next regular meeting.
