- Print copy of chapter's registration and triple check for accuracy before deadline
- Submit registration and print invoice copy
- Submit registration, invoice and payment to South Dakota HOSA
- Book hotel rooms
- Arrange transportation
- Print off and collect [Code of Conduct and Liability Forms](#) form students and send to South Dakota HOSA
- ALL attendees should review the tentative [conference program](#)

- Download the HOSA App to use during ILC
- Pay attention to on-site registration as well as SD HOSA State meeting date/time
