

The following information will help guide student competitors as they prepare for the 2024 SD HOSA State Leadership Conference (SLC). HOSA competitors should be fully aware of this information in regard to the skills and event topics the conference is offering. Competitors are responsible for understanding and following the event guidelines. For events regarding procedures (ie: health professions and emergency preparedness events), competitors may be asked to complete up to 2 different procedures in that event.

Students may compete in up to THREE events...however, two of the events must be online only.

***Note: All rules and guidelines are national guidelines; however, SD HOSA may alter the guidelines that make sense for our state. For example, there may not be a Round 1 rating for a particular event due to lack of numbers and all competitors qualify for Round 2 (ie: Public Health Event)**

HIGH SCHOOL/SECONDARY STUDENTS:

Health Professions Category:

1. Biotechnology
 - a. Competitors will complete **two of the following four** procedures:
 - Skill I: Using Micropipets and Transfer Pipets
 - Skill II: Set up Restriction Digestion Reaction
 - Skill III: DNA Gel Electrophoresis
 - Skill VII: Calculation of Transformation Efficiency
2. Clinical Lab Science
 - a. Competitors will complete **two of the following four** procedures:
 - Skill II: Infection control and transmission-based precautions
 - Skill IV: ABO Grouping
 - Skill V-B: Staining a Blood Film or Smear
 - Skill VII: Inoculate and Streak Agar Plate
3. Clinical Nursing
 - a. Competitors will complete **two of the following four** procedures:
 - Skill I: Administer Medication Intramuscular
 - Skill IV: Inserting a Nasogastric Tube
 - Skill VI: Performing a Sterile Wound Irrigation
 - Skill VIII: Assisting the Patient with Postoperative Exercises

5. Dental Science
 - a. Competitors will complete **two of the following four** procedures:

 - Skill VII: Processing of Contaminated Instruments

a. Competitors will complete **two of the following four** procedures:

- Skill I: Taking an Adult Tympanic Temperature
- Skill II: Taking an Apical Pulse
- Skill IV: Changing a Dry Dressing Using Non-Sterile Technique
- Skill VIII: Applying Elasticized Stockings

8. Medical Assisting

a. Competitors will complete **two of the following four** procedures:

- Skill I: Perform a Telephone Screening
- Skill VI: Screen for Visual Acuity
- Skill VII: Test Urine with Reagent Strip
- Skill VIII: Sterile Gloving

9. Nursing Assisting (CNA)

a. Competitors will complete **two of the following four** procedures:

- Skill I: Handwashing
- Skill II: Donning & Doffing a Full Set of PPE
- Skill VI: Transfer patient with specified disability from bed to chair/wheelchair
- Skill VII: Measure and record vital signs: TPR and blood pressure (aneroid)

10. *Personal Care (IEP)

a. Competitors will complete **two of the following four** procedures:

- Skill I: Handwashing
- Skill II: Donning & Doffing a Full Set of PPE
- Skill VI: Transfer patient with specified disability from bed to chair/wheelchair
- Skill VII: Measure and record vital signs: TPR and blood pressure (aneroid)

11. Pharmacy Science

a. Competitors will complete **two of the following four** procedures:

- Skill II: Verifying Controlled Substance Prescription Content and DEA Number
- Skill III: Withdrawing Liquid from a Vial
- Skill V: Patient Screening for Pharmacist Consultation and Services
- Skill VI: Filling A Prescription

12. Phlebotomy

a. Competitors will complete **two of the following four** procedures:

- Skill II: Tourniquet Application
- Skill IV: Steps to Follow if a Patient Starts to Faint During Venipuncture
- Skill V: Heel Puncture
- Skill VII: Accidental Arterial Stick

13. Physical Therapy

a. Competitors will complete **two of the following four** procedures:

- Skill I: Ambulating with a Transfer (Gait) Belt
- Skill IV: Passive Range of Motion
- Skill VI: Cold Application with Ice Bag
- Skill VII: Transfer from Supine to Sitting Position

14. Respiratory Therapy

- a. Competitors will complete **two of the following four** procedures:

15. Sports Medicine

- a. Competitors will complete **two of the following four** procedures:
- Skill I: Anatomical Landmark Identification
 - Skill IIIA: Taping / Wrapping Ankle (Inversion)
 - Skill IIIC: Wrapping – Shoulder Spica
 - Skill IIID: Taping / Wrapping Wrist/Hand (Circular Wrist/Figure Eight)

16. Veterinary Science

- a. Competitors will complete **two of the following four** procedures:
- Skill II: Identification of Companion Animal Breeds/Species
 - Skill III: Preparation of the Operative Site
 - Skill VI: Wrapping a Surgical Pack
 - Skill VII: Preparing a Feline to Obtain a Temperature

Emergency Preparedness Category:

1. CPR/First Aid

- a. Teams will complete **two of the following four** procedures: The team will have to perform one in each category.
- Skill I-First Aid: Severe bleeding and shock (Rescuer 1)
 - Skill III-First Aid: Open fracture/splinting
 - Skill IV-First Aid: Severe burns (Rescuer 1)
 - Skill VI-BLS: Adult BLS/CPR
 - Skill VII-BLS: Adult BLS/CPR (Rescuer 1 assists)
 - Skill IX-BLS: Adult BLS with AED (Rescuer 1 assists)

2. EMT

- a. Teams will complete **three of the following five** procedures
- Skill I: Patient Assessment – Trauma
 - Skill III: BVM Ventilation: Apneic Adult Patient
 - Skill IV: Joint Immobilization OR Long Bone Immobilization
 - Skill VI: Cardiac Arrest Management/AED
 - Skill VII: Oxygen Administration by Non-Rebreather Mask
